

Implementation

At Tenacres our Art and Design curriculum is delivered by:

- Following the progression of knowledge and skills and suggested subject coverage.
- Working together as a school to ensure skills from previous years are built on, not repeated. (As well as use of progression of skills and suggested coverage documents.)
- Work together as a staff to ensure the children explore a range of artists from the different areas (paint, drawing, print, textiles, 3D form)
 - High quality planning and teaching.
- Ensuring teachers have sound subject knowledge. If teachers need support with a technique they are able to ask the co-ordinator who will help them research and learn more. (Teachers are also confident to do this themselves!)
 - Teachers delivering fun and exciting lessons which create enthused learners. Children enjoy their art lessons and they love learning and applying new skills.
- Teachers who create a learning environment where children can express their ideas freely through art and different media.
- Encouraging children to build upon previous skills by reviewing and evaluating their artwork and thinking about ways to make it better.
- Giving children the chance to look back through their Project Books which follow them through school children can see how they have progressed!

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
