To further enhance the curriculum /choice of topics to enable children transfer & build skills across the topics.

To further enhance Phonics teaching across KS2. Introduce a whole school spelling programme-No Nonsense Spelling

Further increase the % of children achieving greater depth in Writing, Reading and Maths

Children to be able to use skills from each topic to enhance their writing during the next topic.

Whole school Spelling programme enhances children's spelling and is evident in their writing.

Higher % of children achieving ARE in Maths and English across the school. Further reduce any gaps between groups ie boys and girls.

To ensure all children have a good level of attendance.

To work on joint projects with our partnership schools

To further develop our links with our partnership schools.

To further develop 'wrap around care' available on site. Extend this to our feeder Middle-RSA Ipsley

To further enhance the provision for Speech and Language across the school.

To further enhance provision for support and advice for our parents and carers with access to a Family Support Worker (FSW) available weekly.

Increase the number of parents/carers accessing the FSW support.

In addition to our Breakfast Club we have an outside provider – Sneakers After School Club operating from September 2017
