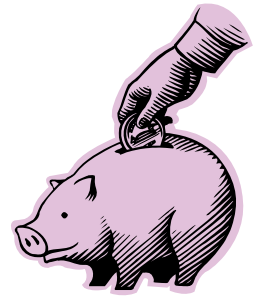
T.A.P.S. Council
