Letters will be sent home this week. If you have recently attended a Pupil Passport meeting there is no need to make an appointment.

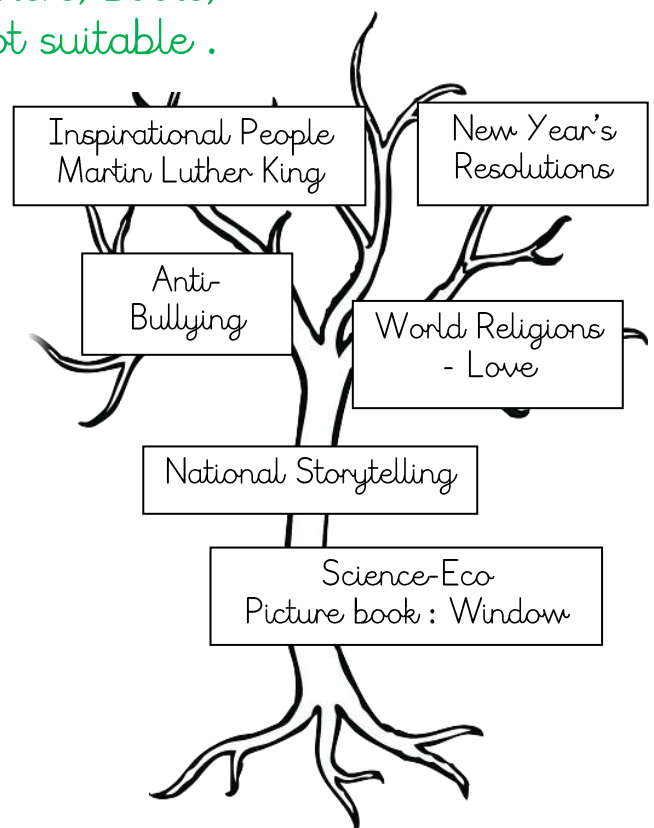


Uniform Reminder

Wednesday 6th and Thursday 7th March – Book Fair

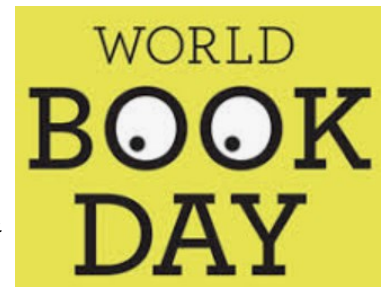
