To ensure all learners have good attendance and maintain whole school attendance to at least 95%+. We continue to work with our EWO (Education Welfare Officer) and families to ensure this.

To further enhance children's passion for a 'love of reading' and read regularly at home.

To further develop sustained writing across the school.

To ensure a consistent approach in handwriting and presentation including the expectations in all subjects across the school. (Ofsted 2021)

To further re-establish the depth and breadth of our curriculum and the experiences children have - i.e. visitors and visits post covid restrictions.

Maths (2nd year of this focus) - To embed problem solving approaches making it accessible to the lower attainers.

To continue to embed mastery in Maths across the school using the 5 big ideas: Coherence, Representation, Mathematical thinking, Fluency and Variation.

Reinstate the assessment systems for Writing, Reading and Maths across the school. (post lockdowns). Ensure assessment systems in other subjects evolve to enable subject leaders to track their subject across the school (Ofsted 2021)

Celebrate the values we hold and share at Tenacres.

All year groups to revert to their year group specific curriculum now we feel the vast majority of gaps have been closed from the impact of lockdowns

To encourage all children to read regularly at home including Phonic Bug Club.

Embed the revised EYFS curriculum and expectations for our Early Years provision

Developing vocabulary in writing through approaches such as 'reading into writing'.

Continue to encourage our children to be resilient learners.

Use 'Letterjoin' handwriting programme across the whole school.

Children to use their Maths skills in problem solving activities independently.

To continue to increase the number of children working at 'age related expectations'.

To ensure children build on previous learning to further develop their knowledge - 'know more, remember more and do more'.

Each year we have priorities to further enhance aspects of the curriculum and the wider provision at Tenacres. Following 2021-22, (the first year without lockdowns) we made good progress in closing the gaps in learning. Tenacres is building on the progress made by embedding the majority of focusses from the last academic year throughout 2022-23.
