To continue to embed mastery in Maths across the school using the 5 big ideas: Coherence, Representation Mathematical thinking, Fluency and Variation.

Ensure assessment systems in other subjects evolve to enable subject leaders to track their subject across the school (Ofsted 2021)

Celebrate the values we hold and share at Tenacres.

Use the 'Letterjoin' handwriting programme across the whole school.

EYFS to use 'Squiggle whilst you Wriggle' to help with physical development in letter formation.

To encourage all children to read regularly at home including Phonic Bug Club.

Lower attaining pupils are confident and resilient with their maths learning

Developing vocabulary in writing through approaches such as 'reading into writing'.

Continue to encourage our children to be resilient learners.

Children will be able to discuss the sequence historical events.

To continue to increase the number of children working at 'age related expectations'

To ensure children build on previous learning to further develop their knowledge - 'know more, remember more and do more'.
