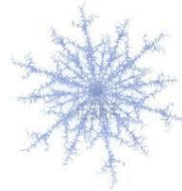

Art / DT

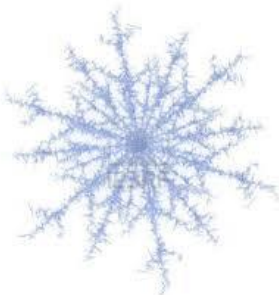
- Develop art techniques such as sketching and drawing.
